Charity Navigator (CN), which analyzes more than 8,000 charities, has just released its latest evaluation of FJC.

With a score of 99.89 out of 100, FJC is the highest-rated community foundation in the United States!

FJC is deeply committed to the partnerships in philanthropy that we have created over the past 20 years. Through these partnerships we can accomplish our mission to:

- Increase and maximize the impact of charitable dollars.

- Create innovative and customized philanthropic solutions.

Over 20 years after its founding, FJC, has some \$255 million of assets under management. In 2015, FJC distributed over \$40.6 million, mostly through donor-recommended grants. And, to date, FJC established over 1,000 donor advised fund accounts and distributed over \$400 million in grants to charities around the world, in more than 25 countries. The FJC Agency Loan Fund has advanced over \$280 million to credit-worthy nonprofits in need of cash in order to accomplish their missions.

Each year, AWARE creates a partnership with one carefully-selected, under-resourced charity. AWARE then organizes a fundraiser, a hands-on volunteer event and an educational symposium based on the needs of the chosen organization and the population they serve. This unique model allows AWARE to shine a focused light on meaningful women's issues.

AWARE was originally co-founded in 1992 by a group of friends -- spearheaded by Rachel Laikind Justus and Amy Frome Saperstein --

who wanted to make a difference in the lives of deserving women and girls in their own community. AWARE's current success is due to a passionate and dedicated team of volunteers, co-led by Cassie Avirom, Kira Copperman, Ellen Friedman and Rachel Laikind Justus in New York City and Amy Frome Saperstein in Connecticut.



This year, AWARE has partnered with charities that serve local female veteran communities. In addition to hosting a multidisciplinary panel on the reproductive health issues faced by female veterans, AWARE NYC is organizing a day of pampering, dinner and theater for a group of female veterans living in supportive housing in the Bronx. The Connecticut chapter has supported this effort by serving dinner once a month to homeless female veterans, assembling diaper bags filled with newborn supplies for pregnant veterans and organizing a panel discussion featuring four female veterans from four different military branches. With donations raised

from the annual fundraisers, AWARE will update an existing website to become a clearinghouse destination for comprehensive resources and information for local female veterans. AWARE has just be invited to accept the prestigious Intrepid Award at the National Organization for Women's (NOW) 50th Anniversary Gala in June in Washington D.C.
