WHILE MOST ACCOUNT HOLDERS AT FJC USE DONOR ADVISED FUND (DAF) ACCOUNTS FAIRLY CONVENTIONALLY (RECOMMENDING GRANTS TO THEIR FAVORITE CHARITIES), WE ACCOMMODATE DONORS WHO WANT TO DEPLOY FUNDS AS LOANS, RECOVERABLE GRANTS, OR IMPACT INVESTMENTS. WE HAVE HOSTED FUNDER COLLABORATIVES, SCHOLARSHIP AND AWARD PROGRAMS, AND OTHER VARIATIONS ON PHILANTHROPIC ACCOUNTS THAT MEET THE NEEDS OF BOTH DONORS AND AN EVOLVING NONPROFIT SECTOR.
