Grant Capitalizes a Revolving Fund for Debt Relief

On the recommendation of donors Andrew Lachman and Ruth Messinger, FJC has provided a \$1 million grant to Hebrew Free Loan Society, which will help hundreds of New Yorkers refinance credit card debt, helping them regain financial stability. The grant funds the Fresh Start Loan program, which provides New Yorkers of all backgrounds 0%-interest, no-fee loans to pay down expensive credit card debt.
