The Bronx Defenders

The Bronx Defenders is a public defender nonprofit that has pioneered a ground-breaking, nationally recognized team-based model of representation that connects clients to an interdisciplinary team of lawyers, social workers, and advocates. Each year, they defend nearly 20,000 low-income Bronx residents in criminal, civil, child welfare, and immigration cases, and reach thousands more through their community intake and outreach programs.

Financing Overview & Credit Terms

Financing Need

The organization learned that their longtime commercial bank would not be renewing its line of credit in the coming fiscal year. Like many businesses, BxD depends on access to financing to even out cash flow, ensuring that lumpy cash payments from contract receivables don't delay services for clients or threaten operational necessities like making payroll.

Credit Considerations

FJC determined that proceeds were highly likely to come from contracts with the NYC Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice and the NYC Office of Human Resources Administration. The organization's scale and private fundraising provided further comfort that the organization could service the interest payments.

Summary of Loan Terms

\$4 million bridge loan for one year at an interest rate of floating Prime +3%
